HOSTEL FOR GIRLS':

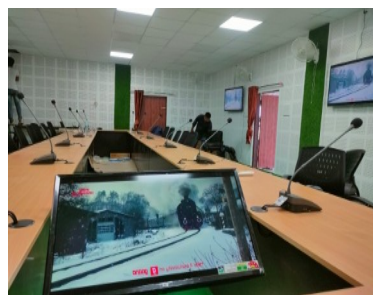

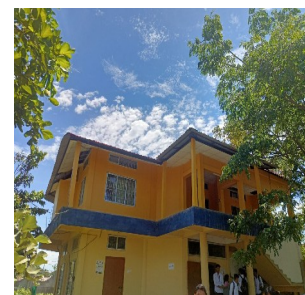
HOSTEL FOR BOYS':
